PRAYER OF FORGIVENESS



FIRST READING Isaiah 43:1-7



⁶ I will say to the north, "Give them up," and to the south, "Do not withhold;




bring my sons from far away and my daughters from the end of the earth—

GOSPEL John 15:9-17

Hear the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ according to John. **Glory to you. O Lord.**
